SUNSET PARK

GENERAL POOL RULES

WARNING! NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY. Sunset Park residents and their guests will use the facilities at their own risk. The Sunset Park Homeowner's Association is not responsible for accidents or injuries resulting from the use of the pool or for the loss or theft of swimsuits, articles of clothing, or other personal items. Homeowners are responsible for notifying family members and guests of the pool rules and seeing that they are complied with. The rules are primarily designed for the protection and safety of our homeowners and guests.

You are welcome at the Sunset Park pool if you are a:

- Sunset Park homeowner.
- Guest of a Sunset Park homeowner must be accompanied by the Homeowner and each household may bring no more than six (6) guests on any given day.
- Only residents ages 17 years and older are allowed in pool when the pool is open.
- Children ages 16 and under must be accompanied and supervised by an adult or by a caregiver who is 17 years or older.

Sunset Park homeowners, guests and children are responsible for:

- Keeping the premises clean: deposit trash in proper containers.
- Remove all food debris including drinks.
- Keeping the restroom clean; report any problems to The Sunset Park HOA.
- Return all pool furniture to its proper location, including lowering umbrellas.
- Closing gate behind them to insure it is latched.
- Do not let anyone into the pool area that you do not know.

POOL RULES

- Pool hours are 9 am 9:30 pm.
- Swimmers must wear appropriate swim attire.
- Children who are not bathroom independent must wear swim diapers.
- Diving is not permitted in any of the pools.
- No running in the pool area.
- Horseplay (shoving, dunking) is not allowed.
- Improper behavior, intoxication, and profanity are not allowed.
- Smoking and alcohol are not permitted in or around the pool areas.
- Food and drink are not allowed in the pool or within five feet (5') of the pool.
- Per State law no glass of any type is permitted in the pool area.
- Chewing gum is not permitted in the pool area.
- Pets are not permitted in the pool area.
- Skateboards, scooters, and bicycles are not permitted in the pool area.
- Large floats, rafts, canoes or any other large flotation device that may pose an obstruction to the supervising adult's view of swimmers or be judged to pose a hazard to swimmers are not permitted in the pool.
- Audio devices may only be used with headphones.
- Phone for emergency use is located at water fountain.
- No throwing of hard objects in the pool or pool area.
- Be considerate of other swimmers and careful of small children around you.
- Be considerate no yelling or other loud noises.
- Swimming will not be allowed during thunder and /or lighting. When thunder is heard, please exit the pool immediately.
- Do not remove the pool furniture from the pool area at any time.
- Pool is not available for exclusive use at private functions.

Health and Hygiene

Please be sure to notify Sunset Park HOA immediately if your child has an accident in the pool (bowel movement or vomiting). We are required to close the pool for up to (8) hours in these instances in order to regulate the chemicals.

How can you help prevent accidents and illness?

- 1. If you have or have had diarrhea in the past two weeks, please do not use the pool.
- 2. If you have a contagious illness, infectious condition, open sores, or abrasions with bandages please do not use the pool.
- 3. Shower or bathe before entering the pool.
- 4. Use the diaper changing station in the ladies' restroom. Do not change a child's diaper at the poolside.
- 5. Toddlers should wear close fitting swimsuits.
- 6. Do not drink the pool water.
- 7. Do not rinse a child in the pool before, during or after a diaper change.
- 8. Insist that your child make frequent visits to the restroom to minimize accidents.
- 9. Please use soap and water when washing your hands.
- 10. Please encourage your child to sit out of the water immediately after eating.
- 11. Management reserves the right to deny use of pool to anyone at any time.
